TO-DO LIST FOR INT'L DEPLOYMENT

CELL PHONE: Activate int'Icalling with your phone provider.

- ELECTRICAL CURRENCY: Research specs in disaster country to see if you need to buy plug adaptors for devices such as laptop, phone charger, personal items. Plug Adapters, By Country: http://international-electrical-supplies.com/plugadapters34.html
- □ INTERNET COMMUNICATION: Determine if internet requires adapative device such as USB AIRCARD or WI-FI UNIT + SIM CARD. Discuss purchase with Kinship Circle.
- □ SKYPE: Kinship Circle meets with team pre/during deployments via Skype, free long distance on your laptop. If you have Skype send request to Kinship Circle to be added as a contact. If not, DOWNLOAD SKYPE FREE VERSION: www.skype.com/intl/en-us/home
- PASSPORT: Current passport that is valid at least 6 months after departure date.
- VISA: Contact your regional consulate for destination country to find out if and what type entry visa is required. Do not apply for visa before consulting Kinship Circle for protocol related to a specific country and disaster circumstances.

- DRIVER'S LICENSES INTERNATIONAL & LOCAL: You're required to carry both an international driver's license and a driver's license from your home state / province. Find Triple AAA offices near you to get an int'l license: www.aaa.com/scripts/WebObjects.dll/ZipCode.woa/wa/route?ipstop=yes
- □ VACCINATIONS: Ensure routine vaccinations are current. Before travel, go to a Travel Medicine Clinic for vacs and antibiotics needed for the destination country: http://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/page/travel-clinics.htm
- CURRENCY EXCHANGE: ATMS are in most major cities abroad. Always travel with money for emergencies, meals, gas, etc. Visit your local bank to convert cash. Use a currency converter to find out exchange rate for destination country: http://coinmill.com/
- INT'L CALLING CODES: Find codes to dial internationally from your home country to the disaster-hit country. Or vice-versa, to call from disaster-hit country to USA. int'l country codes + city and cellular codes, phone books: www.howtocallabroad.com/
